### Communication and Language

This term we will be focusing on listening and attention skills on the carpet in larger groups as well as developing our listening skills in conversation with our friends.

### Personal, Social and Emotional Development

This term we will be settling into our new school and classroom as well as making new friends. We will be focusing on naming emotions through the story of 'The Colour Monster' and building friendships.

# Religious Education (R.E)

In RE we will be learning the Creation story in our Autumn I topic: 'Creation & Covenant'. We will also become familiar with the school prayers and Sign of the Cross. In Autumn 2 we will be learning about Advent and preparing for our Nativity play.

### Physical Development

This term we will be developing our independence with fine and gross motor skills. We will be learning to take off and put on our coats and jumpers by ourselves as well as experimenting with our new climbing equipment.

#### Literacy

This term we will be introducing Phonics to the children and learning letter formation and sounds for each letter of the alphabet. Reading homework will be sent home daily with a new phoneme to review in our Sound Books in order to embed the skills

#### Maths

In Maths we will be focusing on number recognition to IO as well as counting out small quantities accurately, developing our I:I correspondence.

# Understanding o∫ the world

We will be exploring the changing seasons as we enter autumn and prepare for winter. We will be discussing the weather changes daily during our morning routine and learning about our new friends.

## Expressive arts and design

We are learning to colour mix with watercolours and developing our cutting skills in the junk modelling area, both on large and small scales.
