*As your child matures they will begin to come into contact with other people not only in the family but outside. These may include doctors, police officers and teachers. It is therefore important that they understand what they do and how they affect their own lives.*



- ① If possible introduce your child to some of the different people in your neighbourhood. These could include the local doctor, police officer, fire fighter, shopkeeper and lollipop person. It is important that they begin to understand their role in the community.
- ② Encourage your child to draw pictures of some of the people you have met. Your child can use the blank template on page 3 to draw on.
- ③ Set up play activities involving some of the people they have spoken to e.g. hospital, police station, shop, school. These could include using play characters e.g. Lego. Alternatively you will find some printable role play activities within the role play section on iChild.
- ④ Go through some old magazines and find some pictures of people carrying out certain jobs. Cut them out and discuss them with your child.
- ⑤ Together watch a cartoon or programme about someone who has a specific job e.g. Postman Pat, Bob the Builder, Thomas the Tank Engine.
