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Making Models

Making constructions and 3D models introduces a range of fine motor skills and helps with language development.



- Go out for a walk and have a look at some of the buildings in your area. Take some digital photos.
- Provide your child with a range of different sized small cardboard boxes e.g. cornflake packets and some water based glue.
- Talk about the walk and look at the photos.
- Get them to build one of the structures they have seen.
- Use this time to introduce words such as tall, small, rough, smooth, flat and bumpy.

Ask your child to describe what they have produced and how they made it.
