

Making Models

Making constructions and 3D models introduces a range of fine motor skills and helps with language development.



- ① Go out for a walk and have a look at some of the buildings in your area. Take some digital photos.
- ② Provide your child with a range of different sized small cardboard boxes *e.g. cornflake packets and some water based glue.*
- ③ Talk about the walk and look at the photos.
- ④ Get them to build one of the structures they have seen.
- ⑤ Use this time to introduce words such as **tall, small, rough, smooth, flat and bumpy.**

Ask your child to describe what they have produced and how they made it.
