Islington schools and Safeguarding Children's Board response to the 'Everyone's Invited' website and Ofsted's review of sexual abuse in school

We have been saddened and shocked by the recent report from Ofsted about children and young people's experiences in relation to peer-on-peer sexual harassment and sexual violence, including online, throughout schools in England.

Islington has established a multi-agency task group to examine the issues raised and support schools to respond effectively to Ofsted's findings and the recommendations within the report.

As a school we are working with the Islington community to review our practices and consider what more we can do to ensure children and young people feel safe in school, are able to report sexual harassment and violence and that our PSHE (including relationships, sex and health education) curriculum effectively teaches about respect, consent and healthy relationships.
