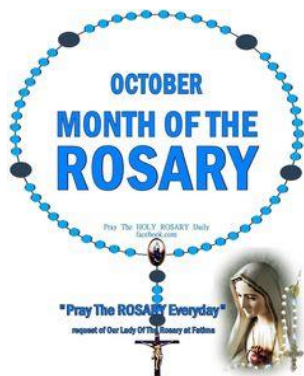

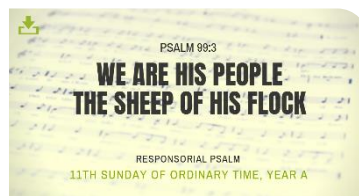
Communion:

The time is here for the harvesting, for gathering home into the barns.

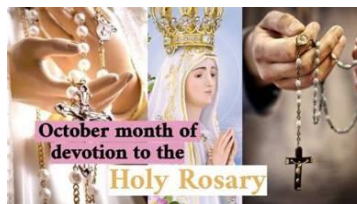
Refrain: The harvest is plenty laborers are few, Come with me into the fields.
